I. Minutes – Kathy

II.

Principal's Report – Mary Bailey

a. Student Course Request Window. February 4-7, 2014

The request window will open at 3:00pm on February 4th, and close at midnight on February 7th. The course request is not registration; it is to allow the school to

understand which classes the students are interested in selected for registration. Arena scheduling will begin in the end of March for seniors, April for juniors, sophomores and 9th graders. The Counselors have also been at Draper Park Middle School to help 9th grade student with questions.

- VI. PLAN/ACT Data Review
 - a. ACT Exam, Tuesday, March 4th (alternate schedule)

 - b. ACT Prep Class (February, \$15.00 a subject)

- VII. Athletics Update
 - a. Winter Sports
Wrestling had many wrestlers go to region and had 5 wrestlers qualify for state competition.
 - Swimming had a great year. The girls swim team took third at region. The swim team had 5 students qualify for state.
 - b. Spring Sports
Tryout dates are included in the SCC packet.

The school also has a new roll-up flag in the gym; it was donated by the Army National Guard.
- VIII. Graduation Venue
Graduation Venues were discussed. Due to the number of graduates, the SCC decided they would like graduation in the main gym.
- Motion: Heather Lambert made the motion to hold the 2013 – 2014 graduation at Corner Canyon High School in the main gym. Seconded by Laura Fidler.
- Vote: The motion passed 14-0.
