I Welcome

Scott welcomed all who were in attendances and invited new members Vanessa Croshaw and Sharyle Karren to introduce themselves to the SCC.

II Minutes

III Land Trust Budget

The school received more money in their Land Trust budget than expected. The new budget did not create any new categories, the new budget added funds to the existing categories. (The school would purchase additional Document Cameras, pay for substitutes so teachers may observe other teachers, and pay stipends for the Robotics teachers, and Building Leadership Team.) Mary requested the SCC to look over the budget presented and approve the new budget.

Cell Tower Budget

The school also received additional Cell Tower money. Mary asked the SCC members if they would approve a conference table for the Legacy Room, receive estimates for cabinets, and hire an aid for the CREW classes.

Mary also requested the SCC members to think about the format for Parent Teacher Conferences. Discuss recommendations next meeting. (28% of parents attended)

VI Enrollment Updates

Mary informed the SCC the office count for the students attending CCHS was turned in on October 1, 2014. The count was 2,036.

The question was asked about the UHSAA and the state 5A and 4A reclassifications and how it would affect CCHS. The process was explained and it was expected that CCHS would stay 4A.

Graduation will be June 4, 2014. The school will not be able to use UVU this year. It was suggested that CCHS hold graduation at the Maverick Center at 12:30pm. The SCC Agreed.

V Activities

Football is doing well, Play Skyline High Friday at 7:00pm. Girls Soccer is in 3<sup>rd</sup> place and playing Murray High this week. Boys Golf is 2<sup>nd</sup> in region at this time. Girls Region Tennis was held today. State Girls Tennis will be held at Liberty Park. Volleyball is working hard and Cross Country is doing well.

Red Ribbon Week, sponsored by the PTSA is Oct 20<sup>th</sup> –Oct 24<sup>th</sup>. Monday night will be a presentation by the PTSA. Attendance school credit will be given.

The school musical will be “Joseph” this year. The dates are November 20<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup>, 22<sup>nd</sup>, and the 24<sup>th</sup>, at 7:00pm.

October 15, will be ½ day of school. Sophomores will be taking the PLAN Test, and some juniors will be taking the PSAT. October 25<sup>th</sup> will be the ACT Test. ACT prep classes are scheduled and can be paid for in the main office.

October 22 will be the Career Fair. There will be 41 speakers, CEO, Mark Meadows speaking to all students with 2 breakout sessions.

October 25<sup>th</sup> is the Halloween Dance.

3 – Stakeholders – survey of each class and teachers

Teacher’s responsiveness in helping students. (survey by students)

Teacher’s communications with parents. (survey by parents)

CTESS - a focus on students being successful and ready for college and/or career ready.
