III. Counseling Corner – Amy Hardcastle

All AP Tests may be registered online until March 18, 2016. Any student who registers for an AP Test after March 18, 2016, will be subject to a \$23.00 late fee per test. It is possible that the school will have 1100 AP Test given to our students.

The school is having a Safe Utah Assembly on Wednesday, March 9, 2016. This assembly will ask all students to download an app on their phones. The students will be able to use this app if he/she feels unsafe, being bullied, suicidal, or if they feel a friend or someone they know is in need of help. This app may be used by texting or making a phone call. This app is to help students understand they have a voice and a place to go for help. This site is anonymous and is considered a crisis hot line for students to use.

Counselors are here at the school each day if a student would like to talk with someone, there is always someone to speak to day or night with this app.

Kathy Cutler informed the SCC that Jennifer Updike had resigned from the SCC. According to our bylaws the alternate with the most votes during the elections in September will be nominated to take Jennifer Updike's position on the SCC. The alternate with the most votes was Adele Lamb.
