- I. Welcome and Establish Quorum – Daniela Dulger
Daniela called the meeting to order 5:02pm. She welcomed all in attendance and establish a quorum.

Sandra Steele was excused. Dina Kohler updated the SCC members on upcoming events and general information from the Student Center.

- Junior CCR's are still in process. Students and their parents meet with the student's counselors and receive information regarding student graduation requirements and what requirements are needed for college. Parents may make appointment on-line with the student's counselor. Reminders will also be sent out via email.
- The Counselors have done a presentation on Financial Lit for students. The presentation will go over what is needed for scholarship applications and how to secure financial aid if needed.
- The teachers have received training regarding the Life Line Suicide Prevention Program. Students are also taught about suicide prevention using the Life Line Suicide Prevention Program in their health classes. This program is supported by Canyons School District.
- Utah College Application Week (UCAW) will be held next week. The counselor will have a Trivia Day on Monday. The Trivia Day will help students learn about different colleges. Tuesday and Wednesday the counselors will be meeting in all the senior English Classes helping the students fill out a college application for at least 1 college. Some of the State Colleges during UCAW week will not charge the application fee or at least reduce the application fee.
- There will be a Financial Aid Night – November 13, 2018, in the Student Center, computer lab. The counselors will be in the computer lab to help students and parents to fill out

financial aid forms. An informational flyer will be sent to the homes in regard to the financial aid night.

- Jordan High has a make-up credit program. A student may make-up .25 credit in 8 days. No original credit options are available through this program. The fee is a Non-Refundable \$35.00.
